Conditions for the receipt of goods on their own, applicable in the company ELMONTER LIGHTING with its registered office in Zagórow 62-410, ul. Przemysłowa 1, NIP 667-000-03-30.

Address of the main warehouse: Michalinów Oleśnicki 34, 62-410 Zagórow

The Elmonter Lighting company, hereinafter referred to as the Seller, will inform the Buyer about the possible date of receipt of the goods in the Order Confirmation or via a separate e-mail.

The indicated term "working days" should be understood as: days counted from Monday to Friday, taking into account the generally applicable provisions on statutory holidays.

The parties will determine the exact date of receipt of the goods (including working days) at least two working days before the planned receipt. At least one working day prior to loading, the Buyer is obliged to provide the Seller with the details of the person collecting the goods, i.e. driver's and vehicle's data.

The buyer is obliged to provide the appropriate method of transporting the goods, i.e. so that the goods will not be damaged. The seller is free from liability for losses, changes or damage to the goods caused during transport. Damage to goods caused during transport does not absolve the Buyer from the obligation to pay for the goods and does not entitle the Buyer to demand the re-delivery of goods free of defects or to demand payment of compensation.

Purchaser, collecting the goods with his own transport, is responsible for the way it is arranged and mounted on the vehicle. It is unacceptable to load the Seller's products on other goods on the vehicle.

Own or rented vehicles designated by the Purchaser to receive the goods should meet the following loading conditions:

- receipt of poles, lighting masts - only trucks adapted for top loading (loading by a crane)
- receipt of foundations and small elements - vehicles adapted for top loading or trucks with side loading (loading by a crane or a forklift).

In the case of pickup carried out by a courier company (DHL, RABEN, SCHENKER, etc.), the Buyer, after determining the details of receipt (including dimensions, weight, packaging method of received products), is obliged to provide the Seller with a minimum of one working day before planned collection, a waybill or in the absence of such a possibility, the order number and the name of the forwarding.

The Seller has the right to refuse to load the ordered goods on the means of transport ordered by the Buyer, which does not meet the guidelines given above.

The Seller has the right to change the date of goods release for reasons beyond his control, in particular: force majeure, behavior of third parties (suppliers, carriers, etc.), natural disasters, weather conditions.

Possible costs incurred in connection with the improper means of transport shall be borne by the Buyer.
